comfortable with one another's names

Recognize that students do not come in a "one-size fits all" package. Vary your teaching style and teach with empathy

TALK TO YOUR LEARNERS AT THEIR LEVEL

Show respect for their thoughts and insights and respect that you will have both introverts and extroverts among your students

CREATE A SACRED SPACE

THE PHYSICAL SET UP OF YOUR ROOM IS IMPORTANT IN PROVIDING ENCOUNTER

MAKE THE PRAYER SPACE THE CENTER OF YOUR ROOM
