



NFCYM Scholarship Applications for NCYC 2019 are Now Available!

Scholarship information for this year's National Catholic Youth Conference (NCYC) is now available. Below are the scholarships and grants that will be offered for NCYC 2019.

Registration Scholarships Offered

Up to 500 total awarded. Full registration covered for NCYC 2019.

Travel and Lodging Grants

Up to \$65,000 total will be awarded. Grants will be disbursed to aid with costs associated with travel and lodging for NCYC.

Anticipated Disbursement Breakdown

50% of funding goes towards under-represented communities.
50% of funding goes towards economic need.

*Each parish interested in applying for a scholarship or grant will need to fill out the **2019 NCYC Scholarship and Grant Application** and send the completed application to Leslie or Mark by email, no later than **May 1, 2019**. The 2019 NCYC Scholarship and Grant Application can also be found on the **E&C SharePoint**. Please note that this is different than our DIOCESAN scholarship and involves a separate process!*
