An effective Learner Centered Goal for a Faith Based Topic: Involves a faith based decision that is directly the topic

· Is a place to aim for; focused on real life results to be achieved by your life results to AFTER they leave the young people AFTER they leave session

·Is evidence of an affective skill (an attitude); a choice or action of the Catholic faith

 Summarizes how your participants will apply the topic in their real lives

· Is written from the perspective of what the learner (participants) will do afterwards and not from the perspective of what the teacher will do during the lesson
