Success!

- HOW MIGHT THEY SHOW YOU?
- HOW YOU WILL EVALUATE IF THEY CAN?



How do I do it?

1. Look back to your Goal and your know, feel/believe and do/decide list

2. Write Objectives

For each group of know, believe & do items, write at least 1 statement of intent that summarizes what your young people can demonstrate back to you

Young people will be able to (action verb) + (object).

See Bloom's Taxonomy & Krathwohl's Taxonomy for appropriate verbs.



If needed for specificity for higher level objectives, use the "ABCD" method:

Given a (condition), (audience) will be able to (behavior) as evidenced by (degree).

3. For each objective, choose an assessment method they will use to demonstrate it back to you.



Head Knowledge

Ask them to write or tell.

- Quiz
- Poll
- Discussion
- Memory Game

- Project
- Paper Reflection
- Movie; Presentation
- Podcast; Infographic



Heart Response

Ask them to show you.

- role play
- self assessment
- demonstration
- create something new

Don't forget formative assessments that you could use during the session! (3-2-1, 4 Corners, Think-Pair-Share, Entry/Exit Ticket)
